


# Pop Up Box Card Tutorial (Original Pop Up Box)

1. Cut your card stock at 8-1/2" x 12". Score on the long side at 2-3/4", 5-1/2", 8-1/4" and 11".



2. Cut off a 2" x 12" strip after you have scored the first score lines. Do this before you make anymore score lines.




3. On the 2" x 12" strip that has just been cut off you want to cut out your insert pieces for the card to use later on. Cut at the 4-3/4" mark on the 2" x 12" strip, cut from the end that has the 1" score line. You should end up with a piece of 2" x 4-3/4" paper that has two 1" score lines at either end. You will cut this strip in half to make two insert pieces. They end up being 1" x 4-3/4"




You can just set these pieces aside.

4. Take your piece of 6-1/2" x 12" card stock (the one that you just cut the 2" strip off of) and turn it to the short side. Score at 2-3/4".




5. Fold on all your score lines. Trim in to the 2-3/4" score line that you just made on each of the score lines. These are your top flaps for your box.



6. Trim away the top piece at the 1" score line and make an angled cut. See the photo.




7. You should now have pieces that look like this.




8. Cut all your layering pieces.

- 1 piece at 6-1/4" x 2-1/2" you will layer this on the inside back piece
- 4 pieces at 3-1/2" x 2-1/2" for outside lower panels of box
- 5 pieces at 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" for each of the top flaps on the inside and the two flaps on the outside that will face up if the card is flattened.



9. This is what it will look like when it has all it's layers.



10. Now adhere the two insert strips. I used red line tape AKA Sticky Strip to put the 1" x 4-3/4" strips in. You will adhere each 1" end to either side of the box. One of the strips should be towards the front and the other facing the back.



11. Now for decorations. Here is what I used. I used circle punches and the heart from the Stampin' UP! owl punch to make the balloons. I used clear window sheets cut into strips to adhere everything to.

1-3/8" Circle Punch




# Mini Pop Up Box Card created by: Wendy Cranford

1. For this pop up box you can use the left over strip of card stock you trimmed of your original 12x12 piece of card stock used for the card above. Or cut a piece of card stock at 3-1/2" x 12". Score at 1", 5-1/2", 6-1/2" and 11"




2. Turn at 90 degrees and score at 2" mark.



3. Trim away the small tabs. Trim angle on the last tab. See photo below.



4. Adhere the 1" tabs together to make your box. See photo below.



5. Cut a piece of card stock at 1/2" x 5", score at each end at the 1/4" mark and add sticky strip. Add your decorations to this strip prior to putting it in the box. It is much easier this way.



6. Now adhere the strip into the card.
