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Z Fold with Window

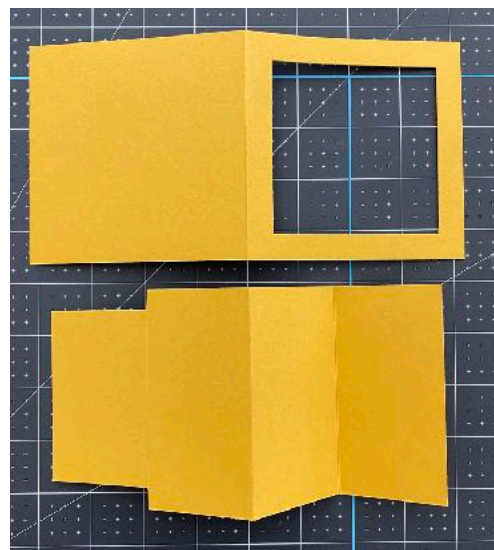


Measurements:

- Bumblebee Cardstock
 - 4-1/4" x 8-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
 - 4" x 8", score at 2", 4" and 6"
- Harvest Meadows Designer Series Paper
 - Two - 1-3/4" x 3-3/4"
 - 3" x 3-3/4"
- Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - 2-3/4" x 3-1/2"
 - 1-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Instructions:

1. Start by scoring the Bumblebee cardstock as listed in the measurements.
2. On the 4-1/4" x 8-1/2" cardstock cut away the center of the front of the card. Measure 1/2" from each side to cut out a square.
3. On the other piece of cardstock score at 3/8" from the top and bottom to the first 2" scoreline. See image. ->
4. Do not fold on the first scoreline. This is flat to add your layers.
5. Add layers to the insert piece of the card. Start with designer series paper.
6. Stamp images on Basic White cardstock and color and add.
7. Glue the insert into the card base. Make sure the front flap can move through the window piece.



Tri Panel Peek A Boo Card

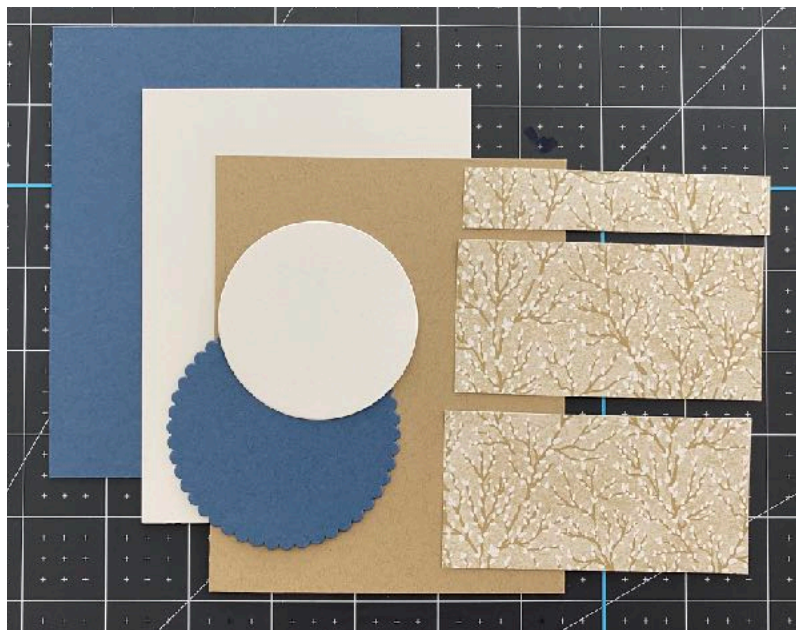


Measurements:

- Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - 4" x 5-1/4"
 - Layering Circle (2-3/8")
- Misty Moonlight Cardstock
 - 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
 - Layering Circle (scallop 2-3/4")
- Crumb Cake Cardstock
 - 4-1/4" x 5-1/4"
- Harvest Meadows Designer Series Paper
 - Two 1-7/8" x 3-3/4"
 - 3/4" x 3-3/4"

Instructions:

1. Score the 4-1/4" x 5-1/4" piece of Crumb Cake cardstock at 1/4" on the 4-1/4" side.
2. Cut the Crumb Cake cardstock at 2-1/8" twice. This gives three strips with 1/4" tab. Wrap and glue the 1/4" tab on the Basic White cardstock.
3. Glue the Basic White cardstock to the Misty Moonlight card base.
4. Layer all of the pieces of designer series paper and stamp and add the image. Stamp the sentiment in the middle of the card.



Festive Fun Border Card



Measurements:

- Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"
 - 3 little ghost die cuts
- Gorgeous Grape Cardstock
 - Label die from Festive Dies

Instructions:

1. Score card base at 4-1/4". Use Post It note tape or masking tape or paper to block off back half of card base.
2. Stamp witch hat border on the right side of the card front about 3/4" from the edge. Ink blend with Gorgeous Grape ink and Fresh Freesia ink. Create an ombre look.
3. Color witch hats with Fresh Freesia Stampin' Blends.
4. Die cut border of the witch hats on the outside edge.
5. Stamp sentiment in Versamark ink and white heat emboss on the Gorgeous Grape cardstock and add to the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Add the ghosts to the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.

Season's Greetings Piggy Card



Measurements:

- Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"
 - 3-1/4" x 5-1/2"
 - 2" x 5-1/2"

Instructions:

1. Stamp the garland in Soft Succulent ink on each edge of the 3-1/4" x 5-1/2". TIP: Using the Stamparatus is a great way to make this process easier.
2. Color the garland lights with Polished Pink, Daffodil Delight and Pool Party Stampin' Blends.
3. Stamp the pig and the sentiment in Memento Tuxedo Black Ink on the 2" strip of Basic White. Color the pig with Petal Pink Stampin' Blends. Color the pig's scarf with Polished Pink and Daffodil Delight.
4. Add a little bit of Pool Party Stampin' Blends under the pig.
5. Add both of the strips of Basic White thick cardstock on the card base using Stampin' Dimensionals.

Basic Blessed Card



Measurements:

- Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - 4-1/4" x 11"
 - Hippo & Friends Die
 - Scrap for coloring and die cutting
- Cajun Craze Cardstock
 - 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Harvest Meadow Designer Series Paper
 - 4" x 5-1/4"
 - 1-1/4" x 4-1/4"
 - 2" x 2"

Instructions:

1. Stamp the sentiment in Cajun Craze ink in the center of the Hippo & Friends die piece, set aside.
2. Score the card base at 5-1/2" and add Cajun Craze cardstock to the front of the card base.
3. Glue the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Harvest Meadow designer series paper to the card front.
4. Add the 1-1/4" strip of designer series paper and the 2" square.
5. Stamp the apples and leaves border in Memento Tuxedo Black ink, color the apples with Cajun Craze Stampin' Blends and the leaves with So Saffron Stampin' Blends.
6. Die cut the border piece on both sides. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to add to the front of the card base.
7. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to add the sentiment Hippo & Friends to the card front.

A Little Something Fun Box



Measurements:

- Misty Moonlight Cardstock
 - 8" x 10-1/2"
- Sahara Sand Cardstock
 - Layering Circles - Scallop Circle
- Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - Layering Circles
 - Hippo & Friends smallest label
- Harvest Meadow Designer Series Paper
 - 2-1/2" x 12"

Instructions:

1. Score the Misty Moonlight cardstock at 1" and 7" on the portrait side (the 8" side)
2. Turn the cardstock and score at 4", 5", 9" and 10". Fold on all the score lines and burnish the edges with a bone folder.
3. Trim in to the 1" and 7" score lines on the tab sections and trim away small rectangles at the top of the box. See image.
4. Use a strong adhesive and add to the front side panels of the box. This is the side without the lid closure. (see video)
5. Use a circle punch to cut a 1/2 circle from the front of the box where the lid will tuck in.
6. Wrap the designer series paper piece around the box and glue on one end. Do not glue the belly band to the box.
7. Add the scallop circle with Stampin' Dimensionals to the belly band.
8. Stamp the bear in Memento Tuxedo Black ink and color with Stampin' Blends. Add to the scallop circle with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Stamp the sentiment in Misty Moonlight ink and add to the front of the bear image with Stampin' Dimensionals.
